

## **RA Supplements:**

PhD students who have been accepted by an advisor are expected to be supported at the level of a Research Assistantship appropriate to the student's level (pre-qual, post-qual, or Candidate). If the advisor is unable to provide the support, the advisor is expected to support the student with a supplemental Research Assistantship which pays the difference between the corresponding TA salary and the RA salary. If the advisor does not have a grant which can provide the supplemental support, the student should be so informed by the advisor.
